

KIAC TRACK AND FIELD BYLAWS

AS APPROVED BY EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE 9/29/2009

Sport Chair for Track and Field: John Davisson, Midway

1. ROSTER

There is no minimum roster to constitute a team.

2. SCHEDULING

There is no regular season schedule in Track & Field, only a conference championship meet as defined below. All teams that sponsor Track & Field must compete in the conference championship meet.

3. SCORES AND TIMES

Must be reported based upon NAIA Guidelines

4. CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP

a. The events that shall be contested at the conference meet include:

100 m	High Jump
200 m	Long Jump
400 m	Triple Jump
800 m	Shot put
1500 m	Discus
5,000 m	Javelin
10,000 m	Hammer Throw
100 / 110 hurdles (Women / Men)	Pole Vault

4 x 100 m relay	
4 x 400 m relay	
4 x 800 m relay	

b. The conference meet will be held as a one-day meet on the last Saturday in April.

c. Each institution may enter an unlimited number of entrants in individual events, but is limited to one (1) relay entry per event.

d. Points will be awarded to the top 6 in each event in the following manner:

- 1st place – 10 pts.
- 2nd place – 8 pts.
- 3rd place – 6 pts.
- 4th place – 4 pts.
- 5th place – 2 pts.
- 6th place – 1 pts.

e. Events requiring multiple heats/flights will be seeded based on performances achieved during that competitive season. If no performances have been achieved in an event during that season that athlete may be entered with no time/distance, but must be placed in the slowest heat. Final placing will be determined after all heats/flights are completed with the fastest time getting 1st place, the second fastest getting 2nd place etc. regardless of which heat that performance was achieved in.

f. Officials compensation for the conference meet will be provided by the conference.

g. The KIAC Championships must be electronically timed.

5. AWARDS

a. Conference Champion - will be the winning individual or relay team in each event.

b. All-Conference team - The top 3 individual finishers in each individual event at the Conference Championship Meet (relays not included).

c. Most Outstanding Athlete (Men's and Women's) – Highest individual point total during Championship meet.

d. Men's and Women's Team Champion – Highest point total wins championship.

e. Coach of the Year (Men's and Women's) - will be voted on by all head coaches after final event.
